GOAL OF THE ASSIGNMENT

To evaluate your ability to:

- Clean up raw voice tracks: remove noise, filler, awkward pauses
- Mix levels smoothly so voices feel warm & clear
- Add subtle SFX or background music if needed without clutter
- Export audio that's plug-and-play ready for upload

PART A: AUDIO CLEANUP & MIX

Your Task:

- You'll receive a raw voiceover file recorded by one of our anchors. Link: <u>https://drive.google.com/drive/folders/1rTC3LzUahY3LEHYzQO9VmFgLebpv-zeO?usp=sharing</u>
- Clean up the audio: remove background noise, hisses, awkward pauses, fillers if needed.
- Balance & mix: adjust levels to keep the voice warm, tight, and consistent.
- Add subtle background music if it fits but keep it simple and smart, never overpowering.
- Export a final version that's **ready to use** for a Think School upload.
